Course code & title

The Units being delivered by COSAMP for TAE40110 are:

Course structure

The course runs over 8 weeks and includes 4 days of face to face delivery (2 days at the beginning of the course and 2 days at the end), while allowing teachers to use their actual classroom teaching during the period of the course to count towards delivery and design units.

The course fee is \$1500 per participant.

Other training and assessment services

Upgrades from superseded qualifications:

BSZ40198 and TAA40104 to TAE40110

By the 17th of June 2012, all VET assessors need to hold the TAE40110 qualification.

The National Quality Council advises that their 2011 policy on AQTF trainer and assessor competencies replaces all references to TAE40104 with TAE40110 and deletes all reference to BZS40198; requiring all VET trainers and assessors to 'demonstrate equivalent competencies' to TAE40110 if they hold the older qualifications.

Upgrading from BSZ98

The COSAMP RPL Upgrade process is designed specifically for teachers who possess the older BSZ40198 Certificate IV in Assessment and Workplace Training (BSZ98) qualification and wish to upgrade via Recognition of Prior Learning (RPL) to the new TAE40110 qualification.

The TAE40110 qualification consists of ten units of competency, of which five are considered equivalent to units within the BSZ40198 qualification, and four are partially equivalent.

One core Unit (*TAEDES402A Use training packages and accredited courses to meet client needs*) has no equivalent Unit in BSZ98.

The COSAMP Upgrade from BSZ98 to TAE40110 is delivered through the following 3-step process:

1. The candidate provides
 - > A transcript of units covered in BSZ40198 to COSAMP
 - > Documentation which explains the amount of teaching in VET undertaken since being awarded BSZ40198
 - > Evidence of currency in their relevant vocational competencies (for example, a Certificate IV in Technical Production and activity undertaken to maintain currency, such as community involvement, weekend work, participation in relevant school functions, etc.)
2. The COSAMP trainer
 - > Maps the candidate's list of Units from BSZ98 to TAE40110 for RPL
 - > Determines where the gaps occur in the qualification
 - > Advises the candidate of the work required to upgrade to TAE40110
3. The candidate is provided access to COSAMP's online learning system, undertakes the activities to meet the identified gaps and completes the required assessment tasks in the negotiated time frame.

Cost: Price for the BSZ98 to TAE40110 upgrade program is \$650

Upgrading from TAA40104

1. Candidates submit a copy of
 - > Their TAA40104 Certificate IV in Training and Assessment
 - > Their Units of Competency completed for TAA40104
2. The COSAMP Trainer will
 - > Match the Units submitted with the relevant TAA04 to TAE10 Units.

Then:

- > If gaps are identified, the candidate will be advised of the necessary requirements. The candidate is provided access to COSAMP's online learning system, undertakes the activities to meet the identified gaps and completes the required assessment tasks in the negotiated time frame.
- > If the mapping is suitable for a full RPL, the student will be advised and a new Certificate will be provided.

Cost: Price for the TAA40104 to TAE40110 upgrade program is \$175
